The RRB Section Controller Recruitment 2026 syllabus focuses on Mathematics, Logical Reasoning, Analytical Ability, Mental Aptitude, and General Awareness. The exam is conducted in two stages (CBT + CBAT), with 100 objective questions in CBT, carrying 100 marks, and a final merit weightage of 70% CBT + 30% CBAT.

Exam Pattern Overview

- **Mode:** Computer-Based Test (CBT) + Computer-Based Aptitude Test (CBAT)
- **Total Questions (CBT):** 100 (Objective type)
- **Total Marks (CBT):** 100
- **Duration:** 120 minutes
- **Negative Marking:** 1/3 mark per wrong answer
- **Final Merit:** 70% CBT + 30% CBAT

- **Data Analysis & Interpretation:**

- Graphs, Charts, Pie Charts, Scatter Plots
- Statistical Curve Distribution, Venn Diagrams
- Multi-source Data Analysis (Text, Tables)
- Data Sufficiency & Arrangement

2. Logical Capability (20 Marks)

- **Logical Reasoning:**

- Binary Logic, Syllogism
- Clocks & Calendars
- Assumptions, Blood Relations, Family Tree
- Logic-based puzzles

- **Reading Comprehension:**

- Passages from History, Society, Literature, Science, Environment, Mythology, Technology, Culture
- Questions on main idea, supporting idea, application, logical structure, and style

3. Mental Reasoning (20 Marks)

- Pattern recognition, decision-making, and mental aptitude questions designed to test quick thinking and problem-solving ability.

4. General Awareness (CBT 2 focus)

- Current Affairs (National & International)
- Indian Geography, History, Culture, Freedom Movement
- Indian Polity & Constitution
- Indian Economy & Environmental Issues
- Sports, Science & Technology Developments

Key Notes

- **CBT is qualifying + merit-based**, while **CBAT tests aptitude for controlling railway sections**.
- Strong focus on **Mathematics & Data Interpretation (60% weightage)** makes numerical practice essential.
- Logical puzzles and comprehension passages test reasoning and reading ability.
- General Awareness ensures candidates are updated with national and railway-related developments.
